PROJECT PHASES

A limited number of Mini-Sites are available in this first round, participation is on a first comefirst served basis. To participate:

- 1) Fill out and sign the SPACE Member Mini-Site Agreement return in paper form to GVF. Also return the Mini-Site Worksheet. Once this is done, we can get started.
- 2) Email the appropriate images. We will assist you to ensure that the photos, pdfs and other uploadable material are in the correct format.
- 3) We will post this information in a standardized format.
- 4) We will train you, in groups, on how to update your sites. You agree to update your site at least once a quarter, and that postings occur at least two weeks before each event.
- 5) GVF posts the Mini-Site.

GVF will provide each participating member:

A Free four page Mini-Site including:

- 1) Home Page. Includes basic information such as artist statement or organization mission statement.
- 2) Photo Gallery. The photo gallery includes up to 12 photos, with captions if you like.
- 3) Detailed Upcoming Events Listings. You have the ability to link to You Tube videos or other sites here.
- 4) More information. Full bio or other information.

The Member will provide:

- 1) A signed copy of the following Agreement, returned to GVF, 434 W. 6th St., San Pedro, CA 90731.
- 2) A hard copy or email copy of the Member Mini-Site Worksheet
- 3) Images, information, events, websites, pdf files, etc. that the member wishes to upload to their Mini-Site, in the format described in the Member Mini-Site Additional Information Instructions, (included.)

The Member acknowledges:

- 1) That it is my obligation to update my Mini-Site at least once per quarter. I understand that if I do not visit my site at least once a quarter the site may be removed to make room for another. Or, GVF may choose to update my site. I understand that this will be evaluated every six months and that I will only be given one written notice to comply before my Mini-Site is taken down.
- 2) That GVF may enter my Mini-Site at any time to update/post information or remove any material at its sole discretion without notice. GVF is held harmless if unintentional errors or omissions to my Mini-Site occur at any time.
- 3) That the Mini-Site page layouts are standardized and may not be customized.
- 4) As an artist or gallery, the events posted on my Mini-Site must include art that I have made with my own hands or gallery shows I have curated; performing arts events that my organization has produced in the District; and Restaurants must be in the District.
- 5) That I will attend one or more training sessions to ensure that I understand how to update my Mini-Site.
- 6) That if I no longer reside in or do creative work in the District, I give up my right to the Mini-Site. However, I am free to list events that take place outside the district.
- 7) That it is my responsibility to inform GVF of any changes to my contact information.
- 8) That events will be posted on a District calendar and the calendar is archived.
- 9) That this website's existence is subject to San Pedro ACE District funding. If the website must come down, we will provide as much notice as possible to permit the members to download their mini-site contents to save for other uses at least three weeks before the site is removed.

To get started, you will need to assemble the photos and information to be included on the site. (Don't worry if you don't know how to do all this. You can also start by submitting the agreement and asking for assistance.) Some of these items include:

ITFMS:

- 1) Artist, Gallery, or Performing Arts Organization Logo (optional)
- 2) 1 Home Page photo: 72 dpi; 300px (pixels) by 300px max; square, vertical or horizontal format ok ay.
- 3) Maximum of 12 photo gallery images: Each photo must be 72 dpi, and approximately 300-500px wide by 300-500px tall, max) Captions may be added for each photo. Also for each of the 12 photos, include a corresponding thumbnail which must be 72 dpi, and 160px by 160px.
- 4) Information on upcoming events, including: title, photo (160px wide by variable height), description, date/time, additional web site link (optional)
- 5) Optional additional information: detailed bio or resume, additional gallery, season or show information, past event highlights, etc., This information will go on a "More Info" page that you will be able to customize with Flickr or Picasa slideshows, pdfs, YouTube videos, restaurant menu, links to social media sites (i.e., facebook) etc.
- 6) Tiny home page banner image: if you want a different one than what is on the main SPACE website banner
- 7) After you become a participating member, you will be able to update your events calendar on the web site calendar.

When you have your information together, and you've submitted your signed agreement and worksheet to GVF, a group training session will be scheduled to instruct you on how to enter and upload information and photos to your new mini-site.
